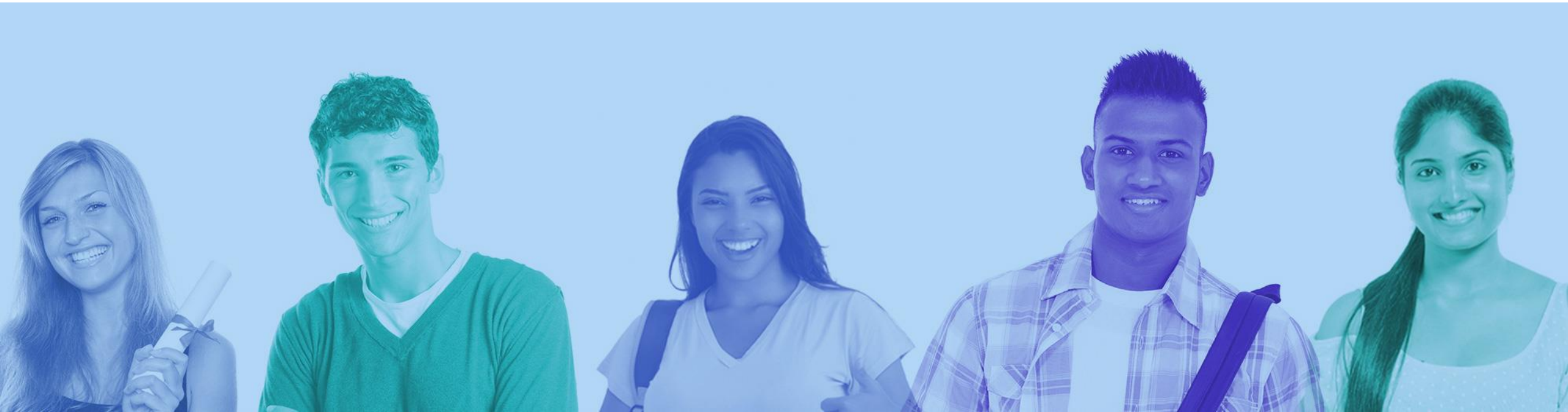

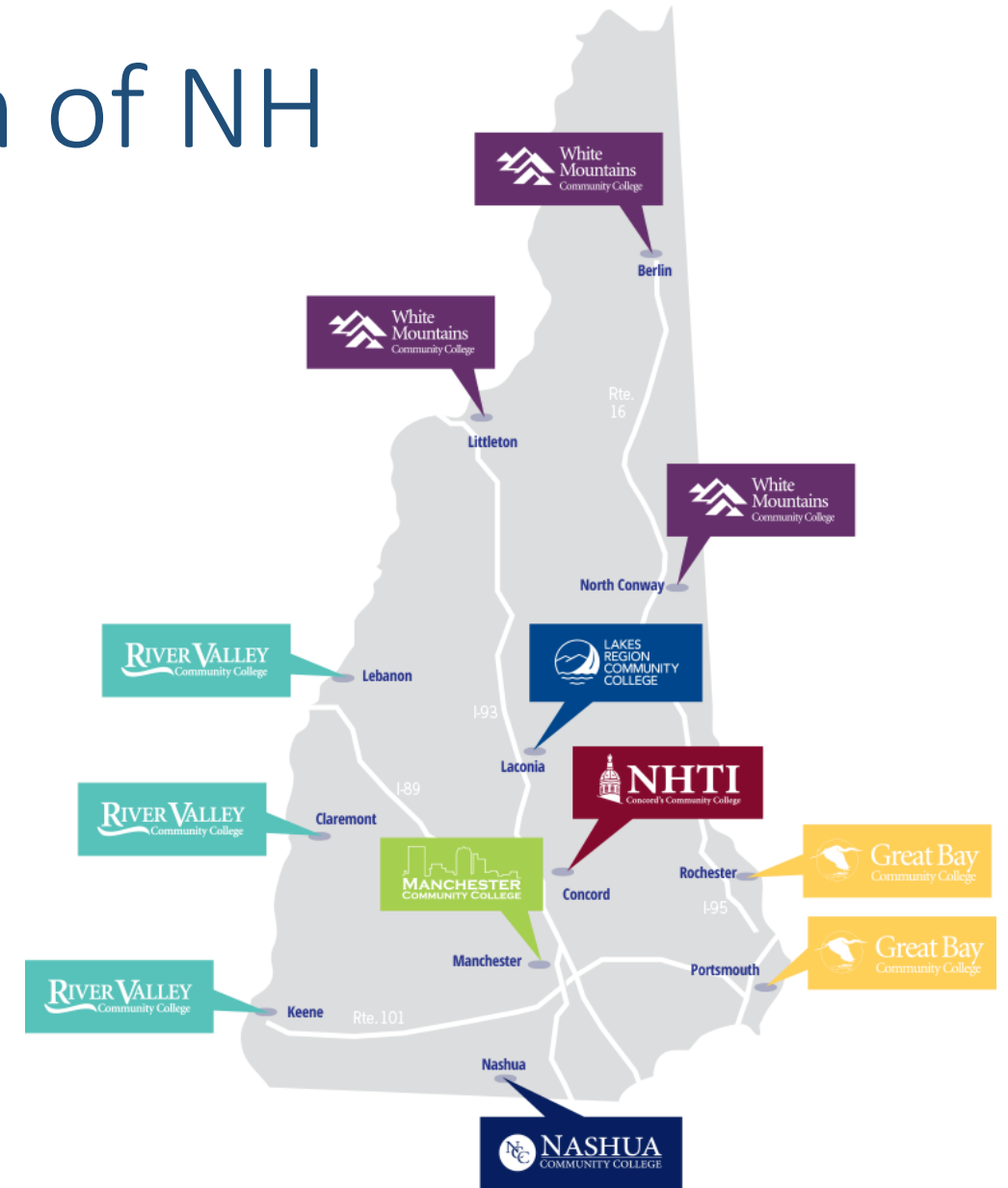

Community College System of NH

- 7 colleges and 5 academic centers
- Associate Degree programs & certificate programs
- Workforce development and training programs
- Transfer and dual admission programs
- 65 by 25 Initiative



ApprenticeshipNH

- Received DOL grant in 2016 to expand RA across the state in non-traditional sectors.
- Assisted over 45 businesses with registering their apprenticeship program, some with multiple occupations.
- Resulted in over 220 apprentices
- In 2019, added a youth apprenticeship focus on a limited basis.



ApprenticeshipNH-High School Grant

- \$3.45 Million US DOL Grant through June 2023
- Focused on developing a pre-apprenticeship to registered apprenticeship pathway
- Begin with Work Based Learning/Pre-Apprenticeship in 10th and 11th grade
- Enter registered apprenticeship in 12th grade



About the Program

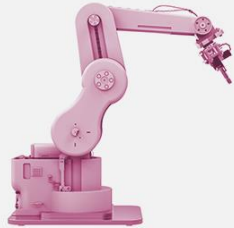


ApprenticeshipNH-HS as Intermediary

- Walk the business through the process of registering their program with Federal Department of Labor
- Help to connect the Registered Apprenticeship program to high school curriculum
- Work as a partner for the business, DOL and school

- National industry certificate

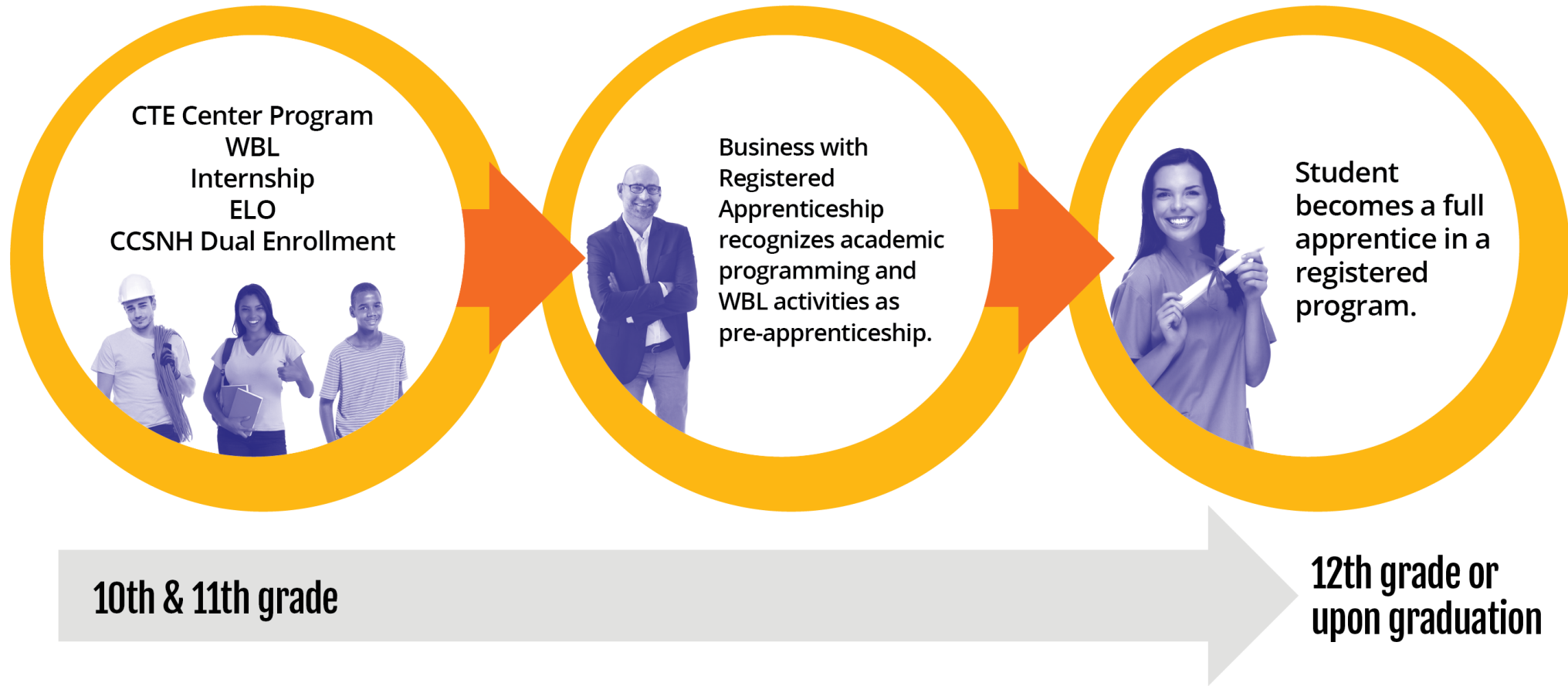


ApprenticeshipNH-High School Grant

- Students can begin related instruction and OJT while in school
- Running Start and Early College courses reduce training costs for the employer
- Advance placement into registered apprenticeship
- Scholarship and support services provided
- Stipends for High School Partners
- On-the-Job training support for businesses



Pathway Pre-Apprenticeship to Registered Apprenticeship

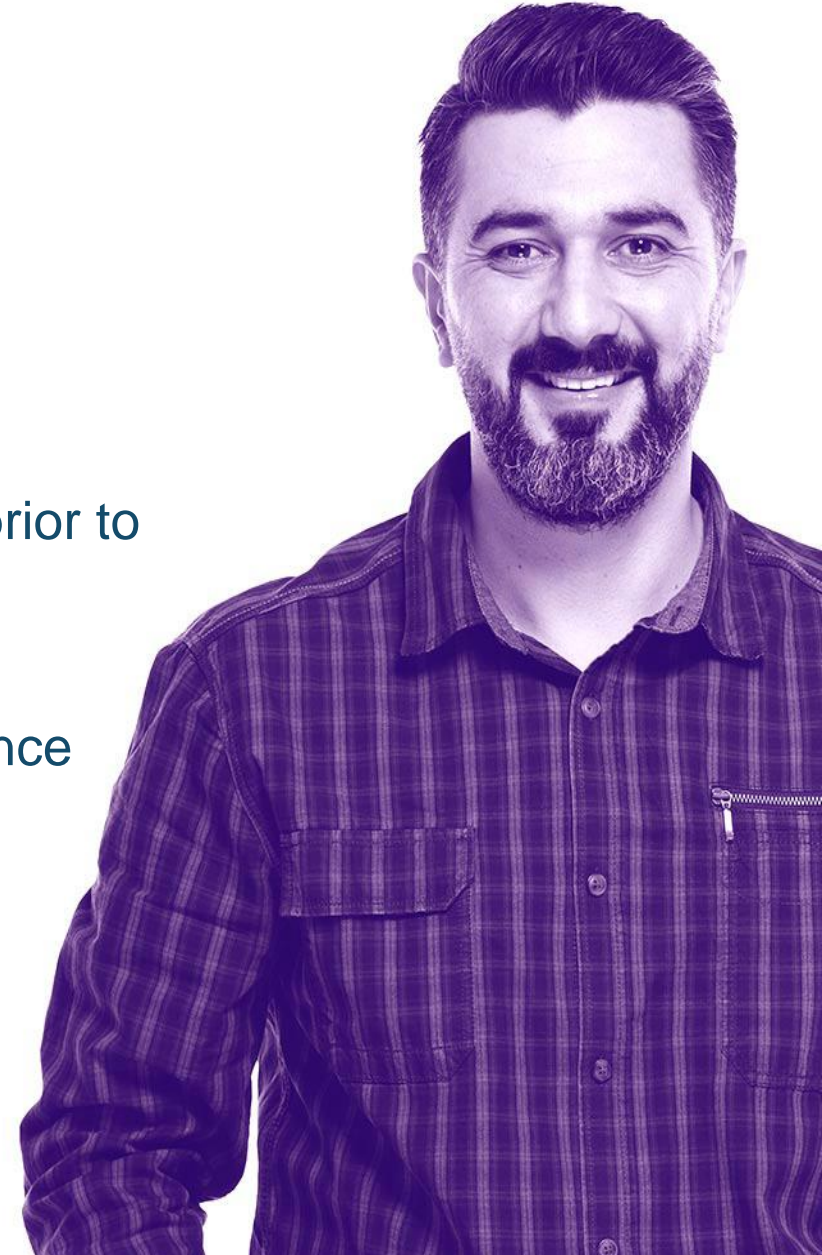


Benefits to the Apprentice

- “Earn while you learn” model
- Hired by employer from day one
- No previous college education/experience required
- Viable career pathway
- Minimal to no student loan debt



- Strategic recruitment plan
- Knowledge transfer through mentorship
- Students demonstrate interest in your business and occupation prior to entry into the registered apprenticeship.
- Pre-apprentices enter the registered apprenticeship with experience and knowledge of your company and occupation.
